This month in the nursery

This month in the nursery, children have been learning about transportation and the various ways people use to get from one place to another. They have been learning about some of the most common modes of transportation, such as:

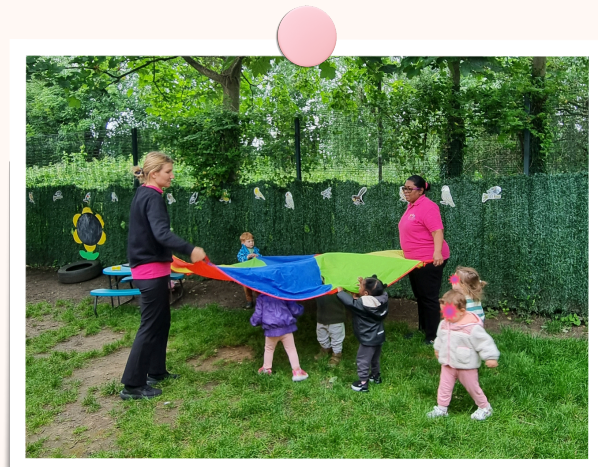
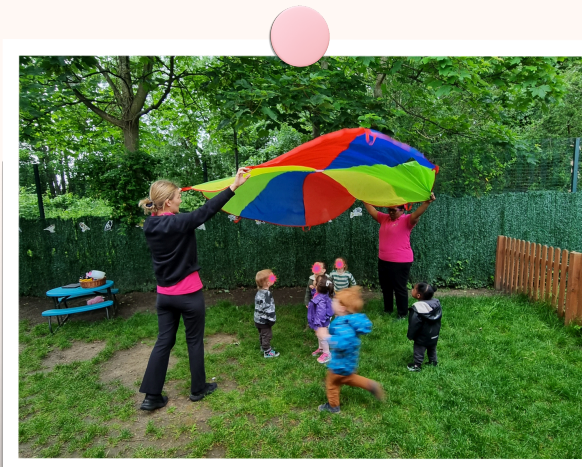
- Walking/cycling
- Boats
- Aeroplanes

We invited them to listen to various stories related to transportation. The older children learned new vocabulary related to vehicle names and different parts of vehicles, such as wings, tires, engines, and pedals.

The children also explored vocal sounds representing different types of vehicles, experimenting with various volumes, lengths, and pitches to mimic the sounds of cars, planes, motorcycles, and emergency vehicles.



This month, the children in the nursery have been enjoying the beautiful sunny weather in the nursery's garden. During this delightful experience, the children have had the opportunity to discuss the weather, as well as listen to and read beautiful stories.





Fire drill

On Friday, May 24th, 2024, we had our regular fire drill at the nursery. It was a successful drill, and we evacuated the nursery in just **2 minutes and 20 seconds**. We gathered at the nursery's assembly point, which is located at Sansbury's click and collect. The children enjoyed the process, and the older children had the opportunity to speak about what a fire drill is and what we need to do in case of a fire.

Parents reminders

Please remember the following guidelines for the nursery:

- Ensure that your children have nut-free sunscreen with them.
- For safety reasons, clogs are not allowed in the nursery. Closed ankle-strap sandals are permitted, but not clogs.
- Parents are requested to check that their child is wearing the correct shoe size. Staff are not allowed to adjust the child's foot while putting on their shoes.
- It's important for parents to make sure that their child is wearing the correct shoe size, and not a larger one, as this could pose a safety hazard for the children.

Safeguarding / Fabricated illness

Fabricated or induced illness is a rare form of child abuse. It happens when a parent or caregiver exaggerates or deliberately causes symptoms of illness in a child. The parent or caregiver tries to convince doctors that the child is sick, or that their condition is more severe than it is. The parent or caregiver may not necessarily mean to deceive doctors, but their actions are likely to harm the child.

It is important to be aware that Fabricated or Induced Illness is a child safeguarding issue that needs to be reported.





For instance, a child may receive unnecessary treatment or tests, be led to believe they are ill or have their education disrupted. If you suspect that someone you know may be fabricating or inducing illness in their child, it is important to report it.
