



Outings Policy Statement

Being outdoors has a positive impact on children's sense of well-being and supports all aspects of their learning and development. Well-planned outings within the local neighbourhood will provide children with opportunities to engage with and develop their knowledge and understanding of the wider world and of those who live and work in the local community.

The Welfare Requirements State:

- Children must be kept safe whilst on outings
- For each type of outing providers **MUST** carry out a full risk assessment of the required adult/child ratio's.
- This assessment **MUST** take account of the nature of the outing.
